


EARCA SOCCER REPORT

EARCA COMMUNITY RINK REPORT

Our 2023-24 rink season had a late start due to warmer than usual fall weather. However, our volunteers got busy as soon as they could and were able to open the rink on December 21 for the 2023-24 winter season.

We have an amazing group of rink maintenance and rink flooding volunteers. I can't say enough good things about them as they give up many hours to make sure the rink is scraped and flooded regularly. There are four main volunteers that regularly flood with a few others that help out here and there.

It is wonderful to see the rink being used all the time. I am fortunate to have a front-seat view of the rink and often get to watch shinny games. The rink is mostly used for shinny by all ages but it's important for everyone to remember that the rink is multi-use and must be safe for those users that don't use it for hockey. This is why there are scheduled supervised skates. Outside of those times, we ask that everyone be respectful and considerate while using the rink.

The rink is in need of repairs. The chain link needs upgrading and we need to add a protective mesh on the north side to prevent pucks from flying to the street. The committee is also looking to adding puck board to the inside of the rink but this will need to be fundraised.

The new building near the rink was handed over to EARCA mid-November 2023, and it was only able to be open to the public a handful of times.

EARCA is responsible for the condition of the rink building during the winter, therefore the warm-up room will not be able to be opened this winter without consistent, committed volunteers who can supervise.

For access to City of Saskatoon grants, the city requires supervised skate times should be for a minimum of six hours a week. For our community, those hours have been Thursdays 6-8 pm, Saturday and Sunday 10-12 (family skate, no pucks or sticks). It would be beneficial if the warm up shack could be open during all other skating hours, but for that we need more volunteers.

We are still offering an honorarium for supervision during our required time slots but volunteers for all other times would be beneficial. If you or anyone you know is interested in participating please contact Cinthya Wiersma at rink@earca.ca.

SYLVIA FEDORUK SCHOOL UPDATE by Dulcie Puobi, Principal of Sylvia Fedoruk School

Sylvia Fedoruk School, located at 628 Manek Road, is a public school named after the physicist Sylvia Fedoruk. She was the first female lieutenant-governor and was also a nationally recognized athlete, competing in track and field, golf, softball, and curling.

The school has over 1,000 students and 90 staff. We are currently accepting Kindergarten registrations for the fall of 2024. If your child will be five years old before January 31, 2025, you are welcome to register. Please see the school's registration page for more information.

Pre-K and preschool programs are offered by Sutherland and Silverspring schools respectively. The daycare and Before & After Care programs located in the Community section of Sylvia Fedoruk are operated by the Boys & Girls Club of Canada. If you are interested in renting our facility, you can contact the school board office and ask for the rentals department.

Due to the dramatic increase in enrolment at Sylvia Fedoruk School, the boundaries for those eligible to register have been closed to include Evergreen only. Families living in Aspen Ridge can register at Silverspring and will be bussed there.

Families who are currently attending Sylvia Fedoruk, or those who have siblings attending, are still welcome to register for the fall.
